

PUBLIC UTILITY LABORER

General Statement of Duties

Perform general duty labor as a member of a utility line, street and sidewalk, or maintenance or ground-keeping crew; performs related tasks as directed.

The work involves performance of routine manual labor tasks under immediate supervision of a supervisor who details work assignments and provides supervision.

Typical Duties

1. Works on a street construction project performing labor tasks such as putting down and spreading surfacing materials, shoveling rocks, hand grading.
2. Works on electric, water and line installation projects; digs ditches, repairs minor leaks.
3. Works on grounds-keeping projects performing duties such as picking up refuse, mowing grass, raking leaves, loading, and unloading equipment and materials.
4. Assists in snow removal operations, dump sand, shovel snow.
5. Operates motorized vehicles, i.e., pick-up truck, dump truck, refuse truck.
6. Reads and records meter readings on monthly basis accurately as assigned.
7. Performs other tasks as assigned.

Education and Experience

Any combination of education and training which supplies the ability to read, write and follow written and oral instructions. Experience in electrical, water and line construction and maintenance are a plus. Ability to perform physically demanding labor tasks and to operate a motor vehicle. Possession of a valid Virginia driver's license required.
